

Within the project "Future Entrepreneurs in Agriculture Prepared in the European Space" I had the opportunity to see a new country with new traditions and customs.


Here I learned to work in a team and consult with people around me before making a decision. I have accumulated a lot of information in the agricultural field that I am sure will help me in the future.



Participating in the Erasmus + project has been an experience that has enabled me to learn a lot of things both professionally and personally.



